The Traveling Team

These kids are the most competitive and travel out of area and out of the division to Freestyle Meets. The team sends a coach to all PNWFS divisional meets, these are held In Washington, Idaho, and Oregon. For all out of division meets, including JOs and Nationals an additional fee is charged to all of those competing. This additional fee covers the coaches' expenses only, the team still pays his/her wages. This additional fee is based on the number of participants and distributed equally. This fee will be assessed and must be paid in full prior to the meet.

Athletes intending to compete at the selected meets must inform Johann Furr, Program Director by the 15th of the previous month. For instance: those that want to compete at Snowbowl on January 15th must commit by December 15th .

FYI This system is based on the method that PNSA uses to handle its out of division races, as well as USSA Western Region.
